We have received evidence that respondent Nancy Anne Mohr, State Bar Number 101119, has been convicted of violating the following:

- 1. In case number 11-C-16798, Health and Safety Code section 11377, subdivision
 (a)(possession of a controlled substance, methamphetamine), a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude;
- 2. In case number 11-C-16799, Penal Code section 490.5 (petty theft from merchant), a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.

As a result of these convictions, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that Mohr be suspended from the practice of law effective December 2, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that Mohr comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.



We will take no further action pending the submission of evidence of finality of the convictions or Mohr's waiver of finality pursuant to rule 5.344(B) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.
