In the Matter of ROBERT DAVID WYATT, A Member of the State Bar, No. 73240. Case No. 11-C-17662 ORDER

Since respondent Robert David Wyatt has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 191.5, subdivision (b) (vehicular manslaughter while intoxicated), a felony that may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective August 13, 2012, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision as to whether the facts and circumstances surrounding the violation of which respondent was convicted involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline, and if so found, the discipline to be imposed.
