On February 3, 2012, respondent Donald Edward Fergus, Jr. filed a motion seeking relief from or extension of time to pay disciplinary costs. On February 13, 2012, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California, by Assistant Chief Trial Counsel Dane C. Dauphine, filed opposition, in part, to the motion.

The court finds no good cause to provide full relief from the outstanding disciplinary costs. However, **GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR**, respondent is ordered to pay reduced disciplinary costs as reflected in the old costs formula, effective prior to January 2011. Disciplinary costs are reduced from \$2,287 to \$1,636. These costs must be paid prior to respondent's return to active status.


