TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On June 28, 2013, Respondent filed a motion seeking an extension of the deadline to pay all restitution in the above matter. On July 1, 2013, the State Bar Office of Probation filed an opposition to that request.

Respondent's financial statement makes clear that he does not have the financial ability to satisfy the substantial restitution obligation due on July 4, 2013. He was suspended from the practice of law during a portion of his period of probation, and he has also dealt with the final illness and death of his mother during the last year. While this court concurs with the Office of Probation that Respondent needs to demonstrate some effort to make restitution, it is apparent that treating his inability to make full restitution as a violation of his probation would be unjust.


GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, it is hereby ordered that the existing due date regarding Respondent's restitution obligation is modified as follows:

1. On or before October 10, 2013, Respondent must present satisfactory proof to the Office of Probation that he has made restitution payments totaling at least \$500.00 since the date of this order;

2. On or before January 10, 2014, Respondent must present satisfactory proof that he has made restitution payments totaling at least \$1,000.00 since the date of this order;
3. On or before April 10, 2014, Respondent must present satisfactory proof that he has made restitution payments totaling at least \$1,500.00 since the date of this order; and
4. The deadline for Respondent to have paid all of the restitution amounts, including all accrued interest, as set forth in the conditions of probation recommended by this Court in its Order Approving Stipulation, filed on January 11, 2012, and incorporated by reference in the Supreme Court's order in this matter, is extended to July 1, 2014.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


