On April 18, 2013, respondent Susan K. Holliday filed a motion for an extension of time to pay restitution and to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). The Office of Probation opposes the motion.

No good cause is shown to extend the time to pay the restitution. Respondent earned over \$17,000 from September 2012 to March 2013. The motion for an extension of time to pay the restitution is denied.

Good cause is shown to extend the time to complete the MPRE requirement. Respondent was unable to register for the prior MPRE tests for several reasons, but is now registered to take the August 2013 examination. Accordingly, the time is extended for respondent to take and pass the MPRE and to provide proof of passage to the State Bar until October 1, 2013.
