On January 27, 2014, respondent Timothy John O'Connor (respondent) and the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a stipulation to modify the terms of respondent's probation in the above-listed matter (stipulation for modification). The stipulation for modification stated specific facts demonstrating that the requested relief is appropriate and serves the objectives of probation.

The court finds that the stipulation for modification is consistent with protecting the public, respondent's successful rehabilitation, and maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. Good cause having been shown, the stipulation for modification is **APPROVED**, and the respondent's conditions of probation in the above-listed matter are modified as follows:

1. The requirement that respondent pay restitution to Susan K. Smith is removed and, instead, respondent is to pay the remaining balance of the restitution that is owed to Susan K. Smith to the Client Security Fund;
2. Respondent is required to continue paying the above-referenced restitution in minimum payment amounts of \$2,000 per month;

3. Respondent must pay all outstanding monthly payments due beginning in October 2013, within 30 days of the effective date of the order approving this stipulation; and

4. Any missed monthly payments beginning in October 2013, and continuing until 30 days after the effective date of this order, do not constitute probation violations.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
