After consideration of the parties' moving papers, petitioner's motion for extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs is **GRANTED**. The court orders that petitioner's time to pay the remaining disciplinary costs associated with case no. 11-O-14765 be extended. Respondent must pay one-fourth of his disciplinary costs along with his State Bar membership fees over the next four years (2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
