The State Bar of California alleges:

JURISDICTION

1. James Harvey Tipler ("Respondent") was admitted to the practice of law in the State of California on June 23, 1978, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

COUNT ONE

Case No. 11-O-15020
Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k)
[Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation]

- 2. Respondent willfully violated Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k), by failing to comply with all conditions attached to any disciplinary probation, as follows:
- 3. On or about December 21, 2010, the California Supreme Court filed Order No. S158221 ("Disciplinary Order") regarding discipline of Respondent. On or about December 21, 2010, the Clerk of the California Supreme Court properly served a copy of the Disciplinary Order by mail on Respondent at the address on file with the State Bar membership records. Respondent received the Disciplinary Order.
- 4. On or about January 20, 2011, the Disciplinary Order became effective, thirty days after the Disciplinary Order was filed.
- 5. The Disciplinary Order revoked Respondent's pre-existing probation, lifted the previously ordered stay of execution, placed Respondent on actual suspension for a minimum of two years with credit given toward the period of involuntary inactive enrollment and placed Respondent on a new two year probation subject to certain conditions.
- 6. On or about February 1, 2011, a probation deputy of the Office of Probation mailed a letter to Respondent at his member records address reminding him of the conditions of probation. Respondent received the letter from the probation deputy.
- 7. As a condition of probation, Respondent was required to submit written quarterly reports to the Office of Probation on each January 10, April 10, July 10, and October 10 of the period of probation, stating under penalty of perjury his compliance with the State Bar Act, the Rules of Professional Conduct, and all conditions of probation during the preceding calendar

quarter. To date, Respondent has not submitted to the Office of Probation written quarterly 1 2 reports due by April 10, 2011 and July 10, 2011. 3 8.
