

On January 6, 2014, Respondent filed a motion seeking relief from the Supreme Court's prior order assessing costs in this matter. In support of his motion, Respondent provided a financial statement and supporting documentation showing his present financial inability to pay the required costs. Respondent asks that his obligation to pay costs be extended over three annual payments so that he may be restored to active practice, thereby allowing him to generate the income required to pay the costs.


On January 8, 2014, the State Bar filed a statement of non-opposition to the motion.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, Respondent's obligation to pay the costs owed as a result of the captioned matter is now modified to require three equal and annual installment payments, with the first payment of one-third of the disciplinary costs to be paid prior to February 1, 2014; one-third of the disciplinary costs to be paid prior to February 1, 2015; and one-third of the disciplinary costs to be paid prior to February 1, 2016.

If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due immediately and is enforceable, both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
