By order filed October 20, 2011, respondent Daniel E. Kritz's default was entered for failing to file a response to the charges in this case. On October 27, 2011, respondent filed a motion to vacate his default.

Good cause having been shown, the motion is granted. However, respondent did not include with his motion a copy of his response to charges. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.83(B).) Therefore, the court will grant this motion conditioned on respondent filing the response within 10 days of service of this order. Upon the filing of the response, respondent's inactive enrollment under Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (e), will be terminated. If the response is not filed timely, the default will not be set aside and the case will proceed as a default matter. Under rules 5.80-5.86 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, if respondent fails to have his default set aside, this court will recommend his disbarment from the practice of law.
