TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

The court filed its Order Approving Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition (Stipulation) in the above-captioned matter on June 14, 2012. At a status conference held on July 2, 2012, the parties discussed the Stipulation and the court's modifications thereto. On July 11, 2012, the State Bar filed Objections to the Court's Modification of Stipulation.

After carefully considering the parties' objections and concerns, and good cause appearing, the court, on its own motion **MODIFIES** the June 14, 2012 Stipulation as follows:


1. On page 17 of the Stipulation, **insert** an "x" in the box, which appears next to the paragraph that states, "The stipulated facts and disposition are APPROVED AND THE DISCIPLINE IS RECOMMENDED to the Supreme Court;"
2. On page 17 of the Stipulation, **delete** the "x" from the box, which appears next to the paragraph that states, "The stipulated facts and disposition are APPROVED AS MODIFIED as set forth below, AND THE DISCIPLINE IS RECOMMENDED to the Supreme Court;"
3. On page 17 of the Stipulation, **delete in their entirety** paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, which appear under the heading, "**ACTUAL SUSPENSION ORDER;**"

4. On page 4 of the Stipulation, in paragraph (D)(3), insert an "x" in the box next to the heading, "**Actual Suspension;**"
5. On page 4 of the Stipulation, in subparagraph D(3)(a)(ii), **delete** the "x" from the box that precedes the words, "and until Respondent pays restitution as set forth in the Financial Conditions form attached to this stipulation;" and
6. On page 4 of the Stipulation, in paragraph (E)(1), **delete** the "x" from the box that precedes the words, "If Respondent is actually suspended for two years or more. . . ."

Any objection to these modifications must be filed within 15 days after the date of service of this order. If either party timely files an objection, the stipulation will be deemed rejected on the date the objection is filed without necessity of further court order. If no timely objection is filed, the stipulation remains approved as modified herein, and the State Bar Court's staff is directed to transmit the record in this matter to the Supreme Court at that time without further delay.
