

On November 14, 2014, Respondent **John Refaat Habashy**, filed a motion for an extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs owed in the above-listed matter. Respondent's motion was based in part on financial hardship. On December 8, 2014, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a non-opposition response to the motion.

After consideration of the parties' moving papers, the court **GRANTS** the motion for extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs. The court orders that petitioner's time to pay the remaining disciplinary costs associated with case no. 11-O-18357 be extended. Respondent must pay one-fourth of his disciplinary costs along with his State Bar membership fees over the next four years (2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
