After review of the motion and response, the court DENIES the motion for relief of disciplinary costs, no good cause having been shown.

The court GRANTS the motion for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, time is extended for respondent to pay disciplinary costs in equal installments over the next three membership billing cycles due on February 1, 2015 and February 1, 2016, and February 1, 2017.


