On April 23, 2014, respondent Letitia Elisabeth Pepper filed a motion seeking an extension of time to successfully complete the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE).¹ Respondent took the August 2013 MPRE, but did not pass. At the time the present motion was filed, respondent was awaiting results from the March 29, 2014 MPRE.

On April 29, 2014, the Office of Probation for the State Bar of California (Office of Probation) filed an opposition to the motion for extension of time.² On May 8, 2014, respondent filed a reply to the opposition. In her reply, respondent noted that she passed the March 29, 2014 MPRE.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the court **GRANTS** the motion. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the time in which respondent must

successfully complete the MPRE is extended. Respondent must provide satisfactory proof of the successful completion of the MPRE to the Office of Probation no later than **May 23, 2014**.³


