A status conference in this matter was held on December 11, 2012. The parties requested clarification of the status of the matter in general, and in particular, whether respondent is currently obligated to file his 9.20 declaration and his quarterly reports. Both of these filing deadlines had been extended, but have since expired. Because there was some ambiguity in the court's previous orders, the court grants the parties' requests for clarification.

The court orders, *nunc pro tunc*, that respondent's obligation with respect to filing the 9.20 declaration is extended until the date of this order. However, as of the close of business December 11, 2012, the extension terminates. Therefore, the 9.20 declaration is due as of the close of business on December 11, 2012.

The next quarterly report is due between January 1 and 10, 2013, covering the period from June 13, 2012 through December 31, 2012.

Because there is no pending issue in this proceeding, the court will take no further action in this matter.


