



Since respondent Joseph Carlye Barrera, State Bar Number 219583, has been convicted of violating Health and Safety Code section 11377, subdivision (a) (possession of a controlled substance—methamphetamine), a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective April 23, 2012, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


