
On November 8, 2017, the State Bar Office of Probation filed a response to the motion, not opposing the current request for an extension of time.

Having reviewed the submitted pleadings, the court finds that good cause has been shown to extend the compliance period beyond November 20, 2017.

Accordingly, Respondent's request for an extension of time is GRANTED. The time in which Respondent may and must present proof to the Office of Probation of her passage of the MPRE is extended until ten (10) calendar days after the results of the November 4, 2017 MPRE are released.
