Respondent specifically denies the conviction in the Complaint involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline.

Respondent specifically denies the crime referenced in the Complaint violation of Penal Code § 12025(A)(2)) (Carry Concealed Weapon Upon Person), one count, a misdemeanor involved moral turpitude analogous to In the Matter of Rose (Review Dept. 1994) 3 Cal. State Bar Ct. Rptr. 192.



Respondent specifically denies that he was engaged in the practice of law at all relevant times in the Complaint.

WHEREFORE, this answering Respondent prays:

1. That the State Bar dismiss the disciplinary proceedings against the Respondent.
2. This answering Respondent be awarded reasonable attorney's fees;
3. This answering Respondent be awarded costs of suit incurred herein; and
4. For such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
