Since respondent David Lin has been convicted of violating 18 United States Code sections 1349 (conspiracy to commit mail fraud [18 U.S.C. § 1341] and wire fraud [18 U.S.C. § 1343]), 1341 (mail fraud) and 1343 (wire fraud), a felonies involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective July 22, 2012, pending final disposition of this proceeding. 
