Since respondent Kent Wycliffe Easter, State Bar Number 199838, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 236/237, subdivision (a) (false imprisonment by violence or fraud or deceit), a felony,¹ it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective December 10, 2014, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.
