

ORDER

Since respondent Michael Patrick Ridley has been convicted of violating Vehicle Code section 23152, subdivisions (a) (driving under the influence of alcohol with three or more priors) and (b) (driving when blood alcohol level of .08% or more with three or more priors) felonies, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective May 13, 2013, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the State Bar Court has not yet received evidence that the conviction is final, the review department will take no action at this time pending the submission of evidence of finality of the conviction or respondent's waiver of finality pursuant to rule 5.344(B) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.


