

On the court's own motion, the order approving the Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition (stipulation) filed on December 10, 2012, in the above-entitled matter is modified to delete the following language "two billing cycles following the effective date of the Supreme Court order" located on page 2 of the stipulation, in the checked paragraph found under paragraph A.(8). This modification is necessary as there is no Supreme Court order imposing discipline in this matter, as the discipline in this case is a public reproof which is imposed by the State Bar Court.

Accordingly, the deleted language noted above is replaced by "2015 and 2016" so that the checked paragraph now reads as follows: "Costs are to be paid in equal amounts prior to February 1 for the following membership years: 2015 and 2016. (Hardship, special circumstances or other good cause per rule 5.132, Rules of Procedure.) If Respondent fails to pay any installment as described above or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately."


