On February 8, 2016, respondent Jamilla Ann Moore filed a motion seeking an extension of time to complete the State Bar’s Ethics School.¹ Respondent attempted to register for both the December 2015 and February 2016 Ethics Schools in San Francisco, but both were full by the time she attempted to register.

On February 16, 2016, the Office of Probation for the State Bar of California (Office of Probation) filed an opposition to the motion for extension of time. On February 24, 2016, Respondent filed a reply to the opposition.²

Consistent with Respondent’s representations, the court has observed that recent Ethics School classes have been listed as “full” a month or more in advance. It is concerning that

² As noted by the Office of Probation, Respondent’s motion for extension of time to complete Ethics School did not clearly set forth why she did not and could not attend Ethics School. Respondent’s reply brief, filed after the Office of Probation’s opposition, better explained the situation.


attorneys who are ordered to timely complete Ethics School are being turned away due to insufficient class capacity.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the court **GRANTS** the motion. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the time in which Respondent must successfully complete Ethics School is extended. Respondent must provide satisfactory proof of completion of Ethics School to the Office of Probation no later than **May 2, 2016**.

Respondent is further **ORDERED** to register for the April 2016 session of Ethics School by **March 7, 2016**. Should the April 2016 session be full, Respondent shall promptly notify the Office of Probation and file a renewed motion for extension of time with this court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
