**TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:**

On February 5, 2016, respondent George Bernard Altenberg, Jr., based on financial hardship, sought an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs (\$26,507.70) assessed in the December 8, 2015 Supreme Court order, case No. S229681. Respondent proposes a monthly installment payment of \$300 per month until the costs are paid in full.

On February 9, 2016, Senior Trial Counsel Cydney Batchelor of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response.

In view of respondent's financial hardship and good cause appearing, respondent's request for extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs is **GRANTED**. Respondent must pay at least \$200, due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, beginning on July 1, 2016, and continuing until the disciplinary costs are paid in full. It is also ordered that if respondent fails to pay any



installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
