On October 12, 2016, Angelina Venegas (Respondent) filed a motion which sought a one year extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). In her declaration in support of her motion, Respondent stated that she seeks this extension due to the continuation of a medical condition and treatment which have caused her to experience extreme pain and discomfort. On October 12, 2016, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade, filed a non-opposition in response. The Court finds Respondent's request to take and provide proof of passage of the MPRE by October 16, 2017, is consistent with protecting the public, the member's successful rehabilitation and, maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.300(B).)

Good cause having been shown, Respondent's second motion to extend the date by which she must prove passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation is **GRANTED**. Respondent is to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before October 16, 2017.


