On February 5, 2015, Respondent Edward William Haase filed a Motion to Extend Time for Probation Compliance based on his failure to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) and the State Bar's Ethics School within the time period required by the Supreme Court order filed December 9, 2013. The Office of Probation of the State Bar did not file a response.

Finding good cause, Respondent's motion to take and pass the MPRE is granted. Respondent has until May 4, 2015, to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation. Respondent's suspension for failing to timely pass the MPRE, effective March 2, 2015, is vacated on the date this order is filed.

As for Respondent's request for an extension of time to attend and pass the test given by the State Bar's Ethics School, his motion is referred to the hearing department for ruling. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.161(A)(1).)


