On January 29, 2015, petitioner Jeremy Tray Ford sought an extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs in State Bar Court case no. 13-C-10604 (motion to extend). Petitioner's motion was based on financial hardship. Petitioner currently owes \$14,261.04 in disciplinary costs. On February 4, 2015, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed an opposition to the motion to extend.

After thorough consideration, the court **GRANTS** the motion to extend, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, the time to pay costs is extended, with costs to be paid in equal amounts on or before February 1, 2016 and February 1, 2017.<sup>1</sup> The court further orders that if petitioner fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules

Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


