

Since respondent Anatoly Smolkin, State Bar Number 274388, has been convicted of violating Penal Code sections 646.9, subdivision (a) (stalking), 646.9, subdivision (b) (stalking in violation of restraining order), 422 (criminal threats), and 69 (resisting officer),¹ felonies that may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that Smolkin be suspended from the practice of law effective June 21, 2013, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that Smolkin comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

¹ Smolkin was also convicted of violating Penal Code sections 243, subdivision (b) (battery on officer), 166, subdivision (a) (contempt), and 626.8, subdivision (a) (disruptive school presence), misdemeanors that may or may not involve moral turpitude. Section 626.8 is divisible. Smolkin was convicted of violating paragraphs (1)-(3) of subdivision (a) and our classification applies only to those paragraphs.



The review department will take no further action at this time pending the submission of evidence of finality of the conviction or Smolkin's waiver of finality pursuant to rule 5.344 (B) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.
