


As the judgment of conviction in case number 13-C-16051 is final and it appearing that the statutory criteria for summary disbarment are not met, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision recommending the discipline to be imposed.

Further, case number 13-C-14863 is referred to the hearing department under the authority of California Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a), for a hearing and decision recommending the discipline to be imposed in the event that the hearing department finds that the facts and circumstances surrounding the violation of Penal Code section 415, subdivision (2), of which Erika Jordening was convicted, involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline.


