On June 13, 2018, petitioner Orion Douglas Memmott (Petitioner) filed a motion to have the balance of the disciplinary costs owed by him as a result of the captioned matter set aside or, in the alternative, made payable pursuant to an installment payment schedule over time. In support of his petition, Petitioner indicated that he is now 78-years-old and attached the required financial statement showing limited income and assets.


On June 26, 2018, the State Bar filed a response to the motion, objecting to any reduction in the amount of disciplinary costs but indicating that it did not object to an installment payment schedule.

The instant motion is filed only in case No. 13-C-14958, although Petitioner makes passing reference in his motion to the \$2,488 of disciplinary costs owed in case No. 14-N-00488. Those costs remain due and payable and are not subject to this order.

Good cause appearing, the time for the unpaid costs in the captioned matter to be paid is extended so that such costs will be due and payable in five equal annual installments, with annual payments to be paid by Petitioner on or before February 1 of the years 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023. If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs will be due immediately and be enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
