

Since respondent Peter Nathan Osborn, State Bar Number 107360, has been convicted of violating Penal Code sections 459 (burglary) and 484 (petty theft), misdemeanors involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective November 21, 2013, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension. As the State Bar Court has not yet received evidence that the conviction is final, the review department will take no further action at this time pending the submission of evidence of finality of the conviction or respondent's waiver of finality pursuant to rule 5.344(B) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.


