On December 16, 2015, respondent John Michael Webster filed a motion for extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE).¹ Respondent plans to take the March 2016 MPRE. Respondent took the November 2015 MPRE, but narrowly failed to obtain a passing score. On December 29, 2015, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade filed an opposition to the motion for extension.

After thorough consideration, the court finds Respondent's motion for extension is consistent with protecting the public; the member's successful rehabilitation; and maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.300(B).) Accordingly, respondent's motion for extension is **GRANTED**. Respondent is **ORDERED** to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before May 2, 2016.
