On November 24, 2014, respondent Barbara E. Irving filed a motion for an extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs owed in the above-listed matter based on financial hardship. The State Bar does not oppose an extension.

Respondent is currently required to pay the costs in three equal installments with her membership fees for the years 2015, 2016 and 2017. Respondent requests that she be permitted to pay the 2015 installment in three portions in January, April and August 2015. The State Bar recommends that the 2015 installment be paid in two portions, one in May 2015 and the balance with respondent's payment of the 2016 installment.

Good cause having been shown, the motion for extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs is granted. However, in view of respondent's current financial circumstances, the court will order that the entire 2015 installment payment be paid with the 2016 installment. Accordingly, the court orders that respondent's time to pay the costs be extended. Respondent must pay the 2015 and 2016 installment payments with her membership fees for 2016. The balance of the costs remain due with her membership fees for 2017. If respondent fails to pay any installment when due, the remaining balance is due and payable

immediately. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
