On June 9, 2014, Respondent filed a motion seeking relief, either complete or partial, from the order assessing costs in this matter. In support of his motion, Respondent provided a financial statement showing his present financial inability to pay the required costs. Respondent asks that his current obligation to pay costs be extinguished or extended.


On June 18, 2014, the State Bar filed an opposition to the motion for complete relief from the cost order but not opposing an order extending the time for the payment of such costs.

After reviewing the above pleadings and supporting papers, the court does not find good cause to grant Respondent's request to be relieved completely of the obligation to pay the previously assessed and still pending disciplinary costs. To that extend, his request for relief is denied.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, Respondent's obligation to pay costs is hereby modified and extended as follows: the sum of the disciplinary costs currently still owed ("Present Balance") will be due and payable in three installments, with one-third of the Present Balance to be paid by Respondent on or before each of the deadlines for payment of membership fees for the years 2015, 2016, 2017. If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due immediately and is enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
