This matter is before the court on respondent Sergio J. Lopez's April 29, 2015 motion to include the costs imposed in case No. 13-O-13886 in the existing costs payment plan for case Nos. 12-C-10338 and 12-O-11661 (not consolidated)<sup>1</sup> and extend the time in which to pay the disciplinary costs for case No. 13-O-13886, so that payment of the disciplinary costs related to case No. 13-O-13886 will be made with and occur over the same time period as the payments for case Nos. 12-C-10338 and 12-O-11661. The State Bar filed a response in non-opposition on May 6, 2015.

Good cause having been shown, respondent's motion is GRANTED. The costs imposed in case No. 13-O-13886 will be included in the existing costs payment plan for case Nos.

12-C-10338 and 12-O-11661; and the time in which respondent must pay the disciplinary costs in case No. 13-O-13886 is extended so that it is the same as that imposed in the existing payment plan for case Nos. 12-C-10338 and 12-O-11661. Thus, respondent must pay the costs imposed in case No. 13-O-13886 along with his payment for case Nos. 12-C-10338 and 12-O-11661 in equal amounts prior to February 1 for the following membership years: 2016, 2017, and 2018.

It is further ORDERED that if respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134.) The payment of costs is enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


