The court issues the following clarification order regarding its June 21, 2016 Order Re Petitioner’s Motion to Extend Time to Complete Conditions of Probation and Pay Disciplinary Costs.

The court hereby clarifies that its order extending the time for Petitioner to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs (numbered paragraph 4) was only intended apply to the portion of disciplinary costs that were due to be paid in 2016. Accordingly, the court **ORDERS** that Petitioner’s time to pay his 2016 portion of the disciplinary costs associated with case nos. 13-O-15484 (13-O-15592; 13-O-17078; 14-O-00305) be extended and said costs are to be paid with Petitioner’s annual State Bar membership fees and disciplinary costs for the year 2017. The court further **ORDERS** that if Petitioner fails to pay the disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar

of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
