On May 10, 2016, petitioner Robert James Ohlweiler filed a motion for extension of time to complete various conditions of his probation in the above-listed matter.¹ Petitioner's motion included requests for an extension of time to complete: (1) Ethics School; (2) Client Trust Accounting School; and (3) the payment of restitution. Petitioner's motion also included ambiguous language requesting an extension of time to pay "past bar dues." The court construes this to be a request for an extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs assessed in the above-listed matter.

On June 13, 2016, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade filed an opposition to Petitioner's requests for an extension of time to complete: (1) Ethics School; (2) Client Trust Accounting School; and (3) the payment of restitution.² As pointed out by the

Office of Probation, there is no indication that Petitioner has made any payment toward restitution thus far.

On June 16, 2016, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response to Petitioner's request for an extension of time to pay the disciplinary costs assessed in the above-listed matter.³ The State Bar did not oppose the requested extension.

After thorough consideration, the court issues the following orders:

1. Good cause having been shown, Petitioner's request for extension of time to satisfactorily complete the State Bar's Ethics School is **GRANTED**. Petitioner is **ORDERED** to provide proof of completion of the State Bar's Ethics School to the Office of Probation on or before **August 12, 2016**.

2. Good cause having been shown, Petitioner's request for extension of time to satisfactorily complete the State Bar's Client Trust Accounting School is **GRANTED**. Petitioner is **ORDERED** to provide proof of completion of the State Bar's Client Trust Accounting School to the Office of Probation on or before **August 12, 2016**.

3. No good cause having been shown, Petitioner's request for an extension of time to pay restitution is **DENIED**.

4. Good cause having been shown, the court **GRANTS** an extension of time for Petitioner to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs. The court orders that Petitioner's time to pay the remaining disciplinary costs associated with case nos. 13-O-15484 (13-O-15592; 13-O-17078; 14-O-00305) be extended and said costs are to be paid with Petitioner's annual State Bar membership fees for the year 2017. The court further **ORDERS** that if Petitioner fails to pay the disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the

remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


