17 COUNT ONE

- 18 1. This count alleges a violation of Business and Professions Code 6068(a) which states:  
19 "It is the duty of an attorney to do all of the following: (a) To support the Constitution and laws  
20 of the United States and of this state." The State Bar alleges that the laws violated consisted of  
21 violations of Business and Professions Codes ("BPC") 6125 and 6126, in that Donald McVay  
22 agreed to refile a civil suit, arranged for research and communicated with the client, Fath, while  
23 inactive as a member of the Bar.  
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25 2. Donald McVay asserts that arranging for research and arranging for other counsel to  
26 represent Fath, and communicating such to the client, does not violate the laws as alleged.  
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


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**COUNT SEVEN**
