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The State Bar of California alleges:

JURISDICTION

1. Randall John Bobus ("Respondent") was admitted to the practice of law in the State of California on December 21, 1977, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

COUNT 1

Case No. 13-O-16121
Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k)
[Failure to Comply With Conditions of Probation]

2. Respondent failed to comply with conditions attached to Respondent's disciplinary probation in State Bar Case nos. 06-O-15379, 07-C-11768 and 07-C-12132 as follows, in willful violation of Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k):

- A. Failing to submit three quarterly reports by their due dates of July 10, 2012, July 10, 2013 and October 10, 2013;
- B. Failing to submit proof of compliance with underlying criminal matters by their due dates of July 10, 2012, July 10, 2013 and October 10, 2013;
- C. Failing to obtain psychiatric or psychological help/treatment from a duly licensed psychiatrist, psychologist, or clinical social worker at his own expense a minimum of two times per month in November and December 2010; July, August and October 2011; June, July, August, September and October 2012;
- D. Failing to furnish evidence by quarterly report to the Office of Probation that he is complying with Mental Health treatment at least two times per month by January 10, 2011 and January 10, 2013;
- E. Failing to timely furnish evidence by quarterly report to the Office of Probation that he is complying with Mental Health treatment at least two times per month by January 10, April 10, July 10 and October 10, 2012;

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- F. Failing to furnish lab reports as required on or before the tenth of each month of the probation period, containing an analysis of Respondent's blood and/or urine obtained not more than ten days previously by January 10, February 10, April 10, May 10, July 10 and August 10, 2012; and January 10, February 10, March 10, May 10, July 10, August 10, September 10 and October 10, 2013;
- G. Failing to timely furnish lab reports as required on or before the tenth of each month of the probation period, containing an analysis of Respondent's blood and/or urine obtained not more than ten days previously by November 10, 2010; August 10, 2011; March 10, June 10, September 10, October 10, November 10 and December 10, 2012; and April 10 and June 10, 2013; and
- H. Failing to submit his Final Report which was due October 21, 2013.

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
