On May 23, 2016, petitioner Patrick Thomas Santos sought an extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs in State Bar Court case No. 13-O-16476.¹ (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130.) Petitioner’s motion was based on financial hardship. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).) On May 25, 2016, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a notice of non-opposition.

Good cause having been shown, the court **GRANTS** an extension of time for Petitioner to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs. The court orders that Petitioner’s time to pay the remaining disciplinary costs associated with case No. 13-O-16476 be extended and that one-half of said costs is to be paid with Petitioner’s annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2017 and 2018. The court further **ORDERS** that, if Petitioner fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court

¹ Petitioner also requested an extension of time to pay costs in case No. 12-C-16759. As that case is not consolidated with the present matter, the court addressed that request in a separate order.

pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
