In May 2013, respondent Jenny Scovis (respondent), her counsel, Kevin Gerry, and the State Bar of California, Office of the Chief Trial Counsel, by and through Deputy Trial Counsel Erin McKeown Joyce, filed a stipulation that respondent be involuntarily enrolled as an inactive member of the State Bar under Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (b)(1) as respondent's serious medical condition has rendered her unable to assist her counsel in her representation in these proceedings.

Having considered the stipulation and good cause appearing, the stipulation is approved, and it is ordered that Jenny Scovis be enrolled as an inactive member of the State Bar of California pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (b)(1), effective three days after service of this order by mail.

Furthermore, the court orders that case Nos. 11-O-12188; 10-O-09741; 11-O-10325;

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11-O-10327; 11-O-11345; 11-O-11659; and 11-O-15088 remain abated during the period of time that respondent is involuntarily enrolled inactive under Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (b)(1).
