ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION AND MODIFYING DECISION AND ORDER

This matter is before the court on the request for clarification filed by the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) on September 16, 2013. Petitioner Corecia Joy Woo did not file a response to the State Bar's request. As the State Bar aptly notes in its request, the court erroneously found in footnote number 4 of its September 13, 2013, decision and order in this proceeding that petitioner failed to verify the petition for relief from actual suspension. Accordingly, the court orders that the State Bar's request for clarification is GRANTED and that the court's September 13, 2013, decision and order is MODIFIED as follows:

- 1. Footnote number 4 on page 2 of the decision and order is DELETED in its entirety; and
- 2. The remaining footnote numbers 5, 6, and 7 in the decision and order are accordingly RENUMBERED footnote numbers 4, 5, and 6, respectively.

In all other respects, the court's September 13, 2013, decision and order remains UNCHANGED.
