On April 11, 2013, Award Debtor Gerald William Filice (Filice) filed a motion pursuant to rule 5.370 of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar to terminate his inactive enrollment under Business and Professions Code section 6203, subdivision (d)(1) and be restored to active status. Attached to the motion was Felice's declaration and proof that he paid the arbitration award in full, including interest assessed as a result of his failure to comply with the award.


On April 22, 2013, the Mandatory Fee Arbitration Program of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed its non-opposition to Felice's motion based on satisfactory proof of payment. The State Bar confirmed with client Gene Webber's counsel that Felice's cashier's check had been received.

Good cause having been shown, the motion to terminate Felice's inactive enrollment is hereby GRANTED. It is further ordered that Felice's inactive enrollment under Business and Professions Code section 6203, subdivision (d)(1) be terminated and that he be transferred to

active enrollment immediately. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6203, subdivision (d)(4); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.370.)
