Since respondent Wayne Albert Boatwright, State Bar Number 150972, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 191.5, subdivision (a) (gross vehicular manslaughter while intoxicated) and Vehicle Code section 23153, subdivision (b) (driving with blood alcohol level of .08% or more and causing death/bodily injury), felonies that may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective July 9, 2014, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision as to whether the facts and circumstances surrounding the violation(s) of



which respondent was convicted involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline, and if so found, the discipline to be imposed.


