ORDER

Since respondent Carmen Lynne Fischer, State Bar Number 117363, has been convicted of violating Arizona Revised Statutes sections 13-1001, 13-2301, 13-2317, 13-2321, 13-610, 13-701, 13-702, 13-801 (attempted money laundering) and 13-1003, 13-2301, 13-2317, 13-2321, 13-610, 13-701, 13-702, 13-801 (assisting a criminal street gang), felonies involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective February 21, 2017, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

Noting that the notice of lack of appeal in this matter is dated May 15, 2014, within 10 days of the date of this order, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (OCTC) is ordered to file a supplemental report explaining the apparent delay in transmitting the conviction record to this court. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a); Bus. & Prof. Code § 6101, subd. (c)



[conviction records which involve or may involve moral turpitude shall be transmitted within five days of receipt].)

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On December 22, 2016, OCTC filed a motion for summary disbarment based on respondent's felony conviction. This court will file separately its recommendation on that motion.
