(conspiracy to commit a crime) in violation of Civil Code section 2944.7 (unlawful advance loan modification fees), with an enhancement pursuant to Penal Code section 12022.6, subdivision

(a)(3) (property damage over \$1,300,000) a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective May 7, 2018, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension. On or before August 8, 2018, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar is ordered to submit evidence of finality or provide an update on finality.
