
On January 30, 2017, Gilbert Alvandi (Respondent), filed a motion to extend time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). By his motion, Respondent seeks an extension of time until the results of the March 18, 2017 MPRE results are released. On February 2, 2017, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade, Esq., filed a response, expressing various concerns but basically stating that her office does not oppose an extension to April 24, 2017.

The court has carefully considered the motion and response and finds Respondent's request to take and provide proof of passage of the MPRE is consistent with protecting the public, the member's successful rehabilitation and, maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.300(B).)

Good cause having been shown, Respondent's motion to extend the time within which he must prove passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation is **GRANTED**. Respondent is to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before May 1, 2017.
