It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

On September 28, 2017, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar filed a request for summary disbarment based on respondent's felony conviction. This court will file separately its recommendation on that motion.
