Since respondent Richard Medina, State Bar Number 228010, has been convicted of violating Title 18 United States Code section 371 (conspiracy to operate an unlicensed money transmitting business in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1960(a) and to knowingly cause or attempt to cause a domestic financial institution to file a report that contained a material omission or misstatement of fact in violation of 31 U.S.C. § 5324(a)(2)) and of violating Title 18 United States Code section 1960(a) (operation of unlicensed money transmitting business), felonies which may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective June 6, 2016, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).)

It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.
