On December 29, 2016, respondent Thomas Patrick Brown IV (Respondent) filed a motion for a second extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (motion for extension). Originally, Respondent's health problems contributed to his inability to timely take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). Following the previously ordered extension of time to take and pass the MPRE, Respondent took, but did not pass, the November 2016 MPRE.

On January 9, 2017, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade filed an opposition to the motion for extension. In its opposition, the Office of Probation points out, among other things, that Respondent received a low score on the November 2016 MPRE and argues that he has not set forth a concrete plan for passing the March 2017 MPRE.

After thorough consideration, the court finds Respondent's motion for extension is consistent with protecting the public; the member's successful rehabilitation; and maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.300(B).) Accordingly, Respondent's motion for extension is **GRANTED**. Respondent is **ORDERED** to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before **April 28, 2017**.¹

IT IS SO ORDERED.
